Applicants should provide a brief description of how they propose to develop the specific thematic focus in each course of interest.

Applicants should also provide a letter specifying their qualifications to teach each course, a list and dates of all courses previously taught at the University of Calgary and any scheduling constraints that would need to be taken into consideration.

Applicants who have taught INTR courses within the past two years need not provide anything further. Other applicants should include the following with their letter:

- a current CV;
- name and contact information for 3 potential referees; and
- teaching evaluations (if available).

Note: Courses that do not reach enrolment requirements will be cancelled. Incomplete applications will not be considered.
